



KI supplied a wide range of Spacesaver high density storage solutions to the BP headquarters in Sunbury. The project made use of KI's wide storage portfolio and includes Eclipse powered mobile storage units, a tailored QuickSpace Library solution and cantilevered library shelving.

Four banks of Eclipse powered mobile units provide BP with a highly efficient, space effective and safe high density filing and storage system. Housing suspension files, binders, manuals and multimedia filing types, Eclipse offers storage for all departments, while allowing personal storage to be reduced in working areas. The huge space saving benefits maximise working areas for BP, while passive safety systems including a photosweep beam ensure safety.

Architects Opus 4 specified KI's Spacesaver products for BP after a thorough review of available high density systems. The high quality of construction and aesthetic flexibility were important considerations.



These benefits are particularly apparent in the choice of QuickSpace units for the Library. Situated within the building's elegant atrium, the QuickSpace solution features bespoke etched glass end panels, elegant beech fronts with slim stainless steel architectural ironmongery, and a clean finished appearance when viewed from above. Five degree angled dips in the cantilevered shelving allow periodicals to be stored and displayed simultaneously.

Eclipse powered high density mobile storage units have been used exclusively by BP at many of their buildings including Canary Wharf, London and Aberdeen, Scotland.
