The potentially conflicting requirement to maximise floor space occupancy whilst maintaining sight lines was successfully resolved by KI at another leading financial services institution : Deutsche Morgan Grenfell. The "low level" KI configuration specified by international Architects Swanke Hayden Connell unite suspended filing and shelving to cover the varied requirements of FX, SWAPS, money markets and other departments.

This combination filing allows traders to store client accounts and settlement records together with a variety of books and manuals within one modular system. KI's ability to provide an integrated solution was a particular strength when Deutsche Morgan Grenfell evaluated potential filing and storage suppliers. KI's experience and close working relationship with SBF1, the dealer desk supplier proved invaluable in ensuring design, visual and functional continuity. For the project the beech veneer finishes of the dealer desks are repeated on the KI units to form printer benches, providing an elegant clean aesthetic.



Functional integration was of paramount importance, with cables discreetly stored in a 150 mm void created at the rear of the KI lateral units.

Together with a colour-coordinated, magnetically applied side panel swift and simple access is allowed to cables and floor boxes.
