



World-leading wealth management company, UBS has installed over a thousand of KI's 700 Series storage units at their Legal and Human Resources departments in the City of London.

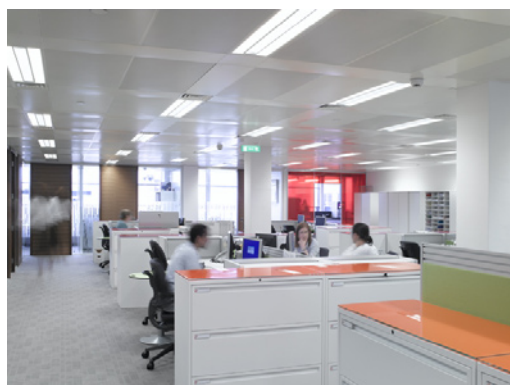
UBS is a global organization with a culture that truly embraces change and this is reflected in their choice of pioneering furniture products.

Out of an audit driven approach to storage and filing issues, evolved fifteen unit configurations, in varying heights and widths.

These were specified and tailored to suit the various requirements of each staff member. With a major emphasis on colour and light, TTSP chose KI to fulfil its aesthetic strategy. Toughened Optiwhite™, low iron, screened and vinyl backed glass tops were supplied in three fresh colours to complement and contrast the glass used elsewhere in the building. This customer driven option is now standard at KI with glass tops available in any RAL colour.

Working to a tight brief with project managers Davis Langdon and fit out specialists ISG, KI supplied all storage for filing and media, pigeonholes for mailing areas and stationery and coat cupboards across the entire floor.
